## DID YOU KNOW...

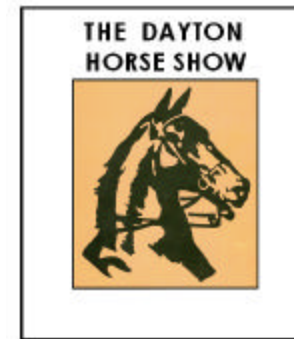
- The Dayton Horse Show started as early as 1912.
- The Junior League of Dayton was one of the first major sponsors of the show.
- During World War II, the proceeds of the Dayton Horse Show benefited the USO at WPAFB.
- Riders from the Dayton Country Club Stables, under the direction of King Tullis, rode down Main St. to the Fairgrounds, in drill team formation, to commence the openings of the Dayton Horse Shows in the 1930s and 1940s.
- In the late 1930s, the Dayton Horse Show Association was formed.
- In the late 1930s, the Antioch Shrine launched their campaign to become the major underwriter of the Dayton Horse Show, with proceeds benefiting the Shrine Hospitals for Children.
